

TIRUMALA TIRUPATI DEVASTHANAMS

- ❖ Vaikuntha Dwara Darshanam will remain open in Tirumala from January 2 to January 11 for Ten days
- Devotees with Darshan tickets or tokens alone will be allowed for Vaikuntha Dwara Darshanam
- For the sake of devotees, TTD has set up about 100 counters to issue Slotted Sarva Darshan (SSD) tokens in Tirupati. The places are:
 - 1. Bhudevi complex near Alipiri
 - 2. Vishnu Nivasam near Tirupati Railway Station
 - 3. Srinivasam near Tirupati RTC Bus Stand
 - 4. Govindarajaswami Choultries 2 and 3 behind Tirupati Railway Station
 - 5. Indira Maidan
 - 6. Ramachandra Pushkarini
 - 7. Jeevakona ZP High School
 - 8. Ramanaidu Municipal High School in Bairagipettada
 - 9. Seshadri Nagar ZP High School at MR Palli
- ❖ The SSD tokens will be issued to devotees from January 1 onwards for Vaikuntha Dwara Darshan from January 2 to 11. All these counters work round the clock till the quota for 10-days exhausts completely
- The devotees having SSD tokens shall have to report at Sri Krishna Teja Rest House in Tirumala
- The devotees shall have to get the updates from TTD official website, SVBC and other media with respect to availability of SSD Tokens and accordingly plan their pilgrimage to Tirumala.
- The devotees shall have to report for Darshan only on the prescribed time slot given on their tickets or tokens to avoid long waiting hours in the queue lines.
- As there is limited accommodation in Tirumala, the devotees with Darshan tickets or tokens alone will be allotted accommodation on First come First basis on their specified dates of Darshan
